

IMPORTANT - USER INSTRUCTIONS

You fridge freezer is an extremely reliable piece of equipment and will give excellent service. There are some certain rules that must be adhered to in order to achieve optimum performance and safe keeping of your goods.

- 1.** Your stock is valuable make sure you lock the door



- 2.** **Do not leave the door open at any time** (cold air is replaced by warm air causing the fridge unit to gather ice. This in turn will stop the fridge from circulating cold air and it will put your stock at risk.) Enter the fridge close the door behind you collect you stock, exit and **close the door**

- 3.** Do not remove the PVC door strips (these help keep warm moist air out of the fridge unit)

- 4.** The interior racking can swing down from any upright position
(Take care when shelving is upright)



- 5.** Do not cover the fridge unit or block the vents

- 6.** Do not pull or kink mains cables (this could lead to electric shock and damage to the fridge)

- 7.** Do not try to move the fridge (it's very heavy and could cause injury)



- 8.** Do not try to adjust the fridge setting unless you have been shown exactly how to do this. The fridge or freezer will be set for you on-site



- 9.** The floor could be slippery & wet
